

# Information and Guidelines for Use and Access to MUSA and Sala Fondatori

#### **Introduction**

MUSA - Museo della Salumeria is a private corporate museum located in Castelnuovo Rangone (Modena), in via Eugenio Zanasi n°24.

Sala Fondatori is a reception hall used for private events for Villani SpA's clients and suppliers and promotional activities organized by Villani SpA.

## 1. Use and Admission to MUSA and Sala Fondatori (reception hall)

#### MUSA

Access to MUSA by individual visitors and groups is allowed according to the contents in sections 3) and 4).

Access is allowed only to MUSA, Bottega Villani and Sala Fondatori, all located in Via E. Zanasi 24, Castelnuovo Rangone (Modena).

The maximum capacity for group visits at MUSA is 15 participants per time slot. However, it is possible to organize group visits with a larger number of participants by coordinating the entry time to MUSA.

Group visits of minors or school students must be accompanied by an authorized group leader or school representative following the guidelines described in the present document and following the norms of good behavior. Before the planned visit, representatives of the educational institution shall review the present document and inform students and teachers of the guidelines that shall be followed during the visit at MUSA. The ratio of minors to authorized school representatives must comply with that established by regional laws for the accompaniment of minors.

Only guided visits by guides employed by MUSA are allowed.

## SALA FONDATORI (Reception hall)

Access to Sala Fondatori shall follow these guidelines:

# a) Maximum capacity of Sala Fondatori is 90 persons.

- b) During events held outside of ordinary operating hours (evenings and weekends), the presence of a Villani employee trained in both first aid and fire prevention is required for the entire duration of the event.
- c) Access will be reserved only to visitors included in the participation list for a specific event.



#### 2. Measures for the Safety and Well-Being of Visitors

Visitors must adhere to the following safety measures established by Villani SpA. It is strictly forbidden:

- to climb over protection barriers
- to lean on widows, displays, or any other setup
- to write, dirty, or deface in any form the walls
- to run inside the exhibition space
- to smoke and bring inside food or drink products. To eat or drink except in allowed areas
- to touch any exposed objects
- to damage or tamper with any object, display, or equipment exhibited indoors and outside according to regulation
- to introduce animals on the premises

Minors must respect the guidelines while guardians, authorized group leaders, and authorized school representatives must oversee the behaviors of the minors under their supervision.

It is forbidden to bring inside MUSA and Sala Fondatori the following objects:

- weapons and ammunition
- explosives or any other flammable substance or gase
- hazardous objects, or objects that are excessively heavy or voluminous
- animals
- any type of alcoholic beverage or alcoholic substances

Smoking is forbidden inside MUSA, except for the reserved smoking area.

Visitors are forbidden from committing actions that may compromise the safety of persons and objects. Every incident or anomaly must be immediately reported to designated Villani personnel.

In the case of a fire, visitors must evacuate the premises following the designated personnel's instructions in a timely and orderly manner.

# 3. Opening Days and Times for Guided Tours

# MUSA is open from Thursday to Sunday with guided tours that begin at the following times:

Thursday to Saturday: 10:00; 11:00; 12:00; 1:00 pm; 2:00 pm; 3:00 pm; 4:00 pm; 5:00 pm (last visit)

Sunday: 10:00; 11:00; 12:00 (last visit)



MUSA is closed on the following holidays: December 23, 2024 to January 8, 2025; Easter; from August 11 to August 28, November 1; December 8; from December 22 to January 7, 2026.

Holidays during which MUSA is open: April 25, May 1, June 2 when these dates fall on MUSA's opening days (Thursday to Sunday morning) and according to availability. All requests must be made ahead of time, directly to MUSA at <a href="mailto:info@museodellasalumeria.it">info@museodellasalumeria.it</a>, and are subject to availability.

#### 4. How to book your visit

Modenatur is the official booking center for guided visits to Museo della Salumeria. It is suggested to purchase tickets online by choosing the preferred entry time slot. ### 7. Cancellation Policy

#### For individual visitors

Cancellation policy: tickets purchased online from MUSA's website or through Modenatur/IAT Modena Tourist Information Center are non-refundable. In case of cancellation, visitors shall inform Modenatur by telephone at +39 059 22 00 22 or by email <a href="mailto:info@modenatur.it">info@modenatur.it</a>. For cancellations communicated to Modenatur at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled visit, the entry ticket will not be refunded; however, the visit may be rebooked at a later date.

### For Group Bookings

To confirm a group visit, a deposit of 20% of the total fee is required at least 10 days before the tour date.

Cancellation policy: for group tours (a group with more than 10 people) booked through Modenatur or directly with MUSA have the following cancellation policy:

- 3 calendar days prior to the visit: it is possible to cancel the group visit or rebook the group visit without penalties.
- 2 calendar days prior to the visit: for a group visit cancellation, a penalty is applied the deposit made at the time of booking will not be refunded. It is possible to rebook the group visit without any penalty.



- 1 calendar day prior to the visit: for cancellation or rebooking, a penalty is applied the deposit made at the time of booking will not be refunded.
- cancellation on the same day of the visit or no shows: the entire amount of the visit will be billed to the client.
